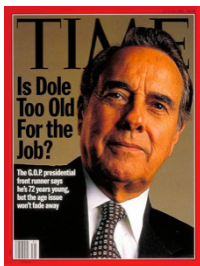

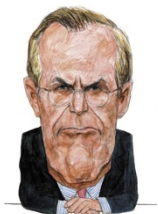
A study that fed beef to rabbits found “beyond any chance of controversy” that animal proteins causes arteriosclerosis in humans. What’s the problem?
